Madhavi Thampi is an Honorary Fellow at the Institute of Chinese Studies, and Editor of its journal China Report. She was an Associate Professor at the Department of East Asian Studies in Delhi University, where she taught Chinese History. Her publications include the monograph *Indians in China*, 1800-1949 (2005). She has co-authored (with Brij Tankha) *Narratives of Asia from India, Japan and China* (2005), as well as a book entitled *China and the Making of Bombay* (with Shalini Saksena, 2009). She is also the editor of the volume *India and China in the Colonial World* (2005, 2010). She recently coordinated a project to catalogue materials related to modern China in the National Archives of India, and is also a member of the Expert Group involved in compiling the *Encyclopaedia of India-China Cultural Contacts* jointly sponsored by the Government of India and the Government of the People's Republic of China.
