The **All India Conference of China Studies (AICCS)** is the flagship event of the Institute of Chinese Studies (ICS), convened annually in collaboration with an Indian University, with the principal objective of spreading interest in and strengthening research on China and East Asian Studies in India. The **Special Theme** of the 14th AICCS is **“Society and Culture in China”**. *In addition to the Special Theme, individual abstracts and panel proposals on all China-related topics and themes may be submitted.*

Date **11-13 November 2021**

Deadlines **01 July 2021:** Last date for receiving abstracts (250-300 words)

12 July 2021: Notification of shortlisted abstracts

12 September 2021: Last date for receiving full papers (5000-6000 words)

11 October 2021: Announcement of final papers

We accept abstracts in the following formats:

1. Individual Abstracts: should mention the author's name, institutional affiliation, email and postal address, together with the title of the paper and a brief bio.
2. Panel Proposals: 3-4 paper abstracts, including name of the panel organiser, chair and participants, and optionally a discussant.

The best paper presented by a young & emerging scholar at AICCS will be given the ***Mira Sinha Bhattacharjea Award***, with a prize money of Rs.25,000/-. Selection will be made on the basis of methodology, argument and presentation. The selected paper will be published by ICS.
